## DEAF SUPPORT VOLUNTARY ORGANISATION ANNUAL REPORT 2017

The year began with the preparation and publication of a booklet of handouts on the phonology of BSL. In March it was published on the Deaf Support website resources page. We received a request by the Association of British Sign Language Teachers and Assessors (ABLSTA) to add it to their website, and this was agreed.

This was followed by the publication of a booklet of handouts on BSL grammar which met a favourable response from Deaf Support members.

After receiving a request from a mother of a deaf child in Bedford for sign language tuition, we made contact with Keith Clark and visited the 'Young at Heart' group at the Salvation Army Café in Bedford. The group meets once a month and is frequented by BSL users who can advise on where to go for BSL classes in the Bedford area.

Thanks to Linda Squelch and Frances Elton for allowing Sandra to give copies of their book and DVD London and South East Regional Signs to Bedford College and City Lit libraries for use by staff and students involved in BSL courses. Distribution to other establishments that provide BSL classes will continue.

During the summer we met with teachers working in Bedford and Luton and gave them e-resources for BSL lessons levels 1-3, suitable for pupils and adult learners.



In September, following a request for help via our website, one of our deaf members visited a family with a toddler who needed BSL as a first language.

This year two deaf BSL teachers passed away: Sheila Webster in March and



Doreen Monk in September. Both worked in the Bedfordshire Hearing Impaired Service during the 1980s and 90s: Sheila as a peripatetic teacher of BSL; Doreen as a tutor in FE and on the CSW course. Their work is greatly appreciated by pupil, students and families with deaf children. They are remembered fondly by colleagues who worked with them.
